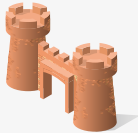

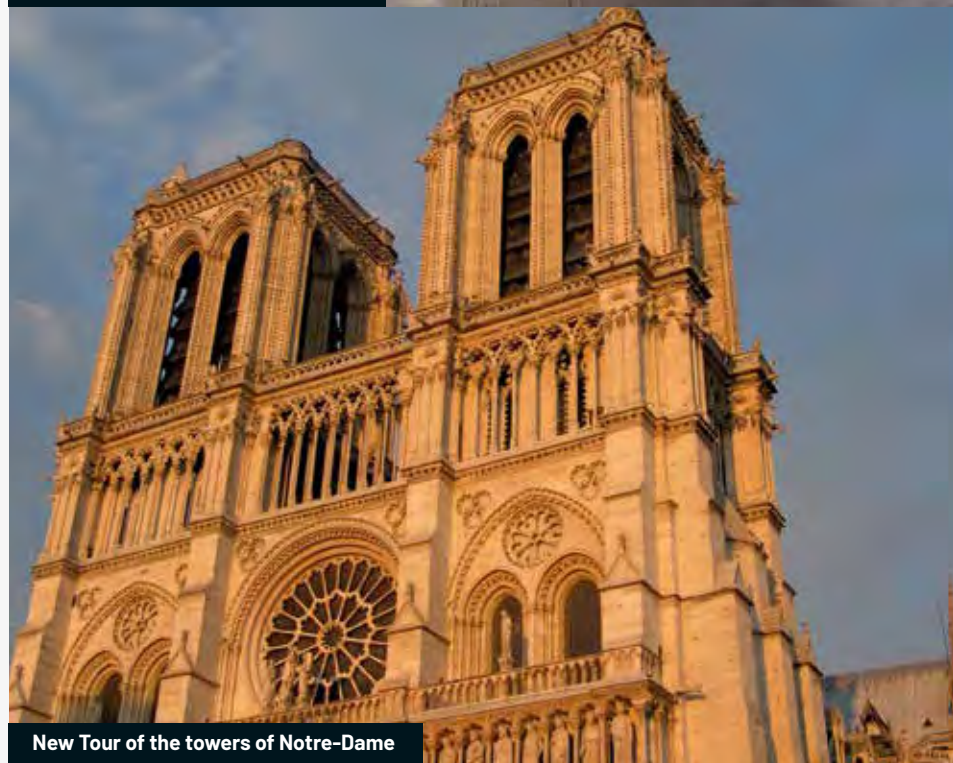

Around the Place de la Concorde



The architectural landscape of the destination is gradually changing... Discover these major redevelopment projects.

Begun before the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, the transformation continues to create a **garden square**: two-thirds dedicated to pedestrians, numerous green spaces, a cool oasis, pedestrian access to the Seine, etc. (by 2030).

Around Culture

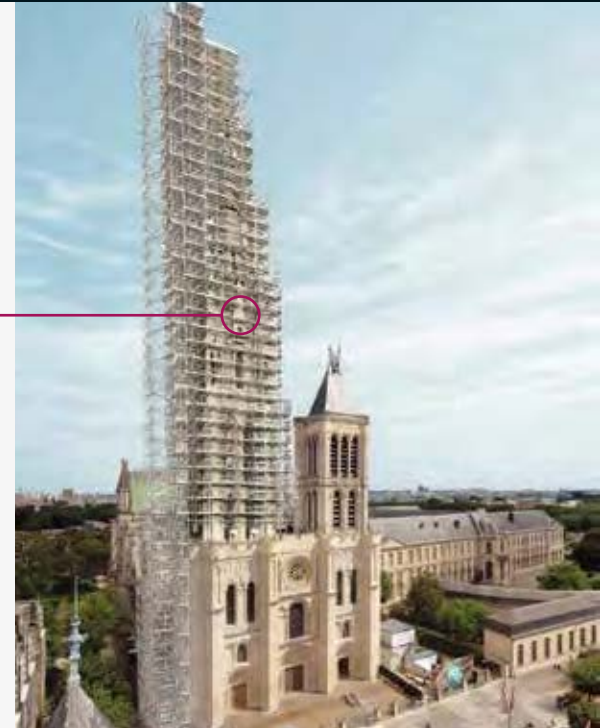


- **The Musée du Grand Siècle in Saint-Cloud** will offer a comprehensive overview of 17th-century French history and art (2027).
- The future **Le Corbusier Museum in Poissy**, near the Villa Savoye (2027).
- New exhibition trails, a second entrance, a new home for the *Mona Lisa*... **The Louvre** is embarking on a major renovation project to revitalise the museum (due for completion in 2031).
- A research and conservation centre, the **Centre Pompidou Francilien – Fabrique de l'Art / Musée National Picasso-Paris** will offer the public new access to modern art and contemporary creation (Autumn 2026).

Around the Basilica-Cathedral of Saint-Denis

La Fabrique de la flèche, a technological journey with immersive cinema and virtual reality.

New Tour of the Basilica in French, English and Spanish, with animated films, multimedia screens, digital information panels, etc.





Paris Region

Renewal 2025 > 2031

A new silhouette on the Paris skyline: pyramid-shaped, entirely glass-fronted and compact, ultra-connected and inclusive, **the Triangle Tower** will include a hotel, restaurant and rooftop bar, shops, outdoor spaces, and more (summer 2026).

- **New Tour of the towers of Notre-Dame**, an immersive and audio experience.

- **New courtyard** (by 2028)

- Underground car park converted into an **indoor promenade**, spanning 3,000 m² and serving as a climate-controlled shelter and reception area.

- **New stained glass windows** by French artist Claire Tabouret (end of 2026). Full-scale models will be on display as part of the *Invitation to Claire Tabouret and Eva Jospin* exhibition at the Grand Palais (end of 2025).

- **Riverfront park stretching 400 metres**, leading to the flying buttresses and stained glass windows (by 2028).

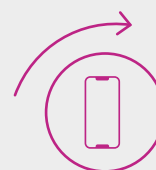

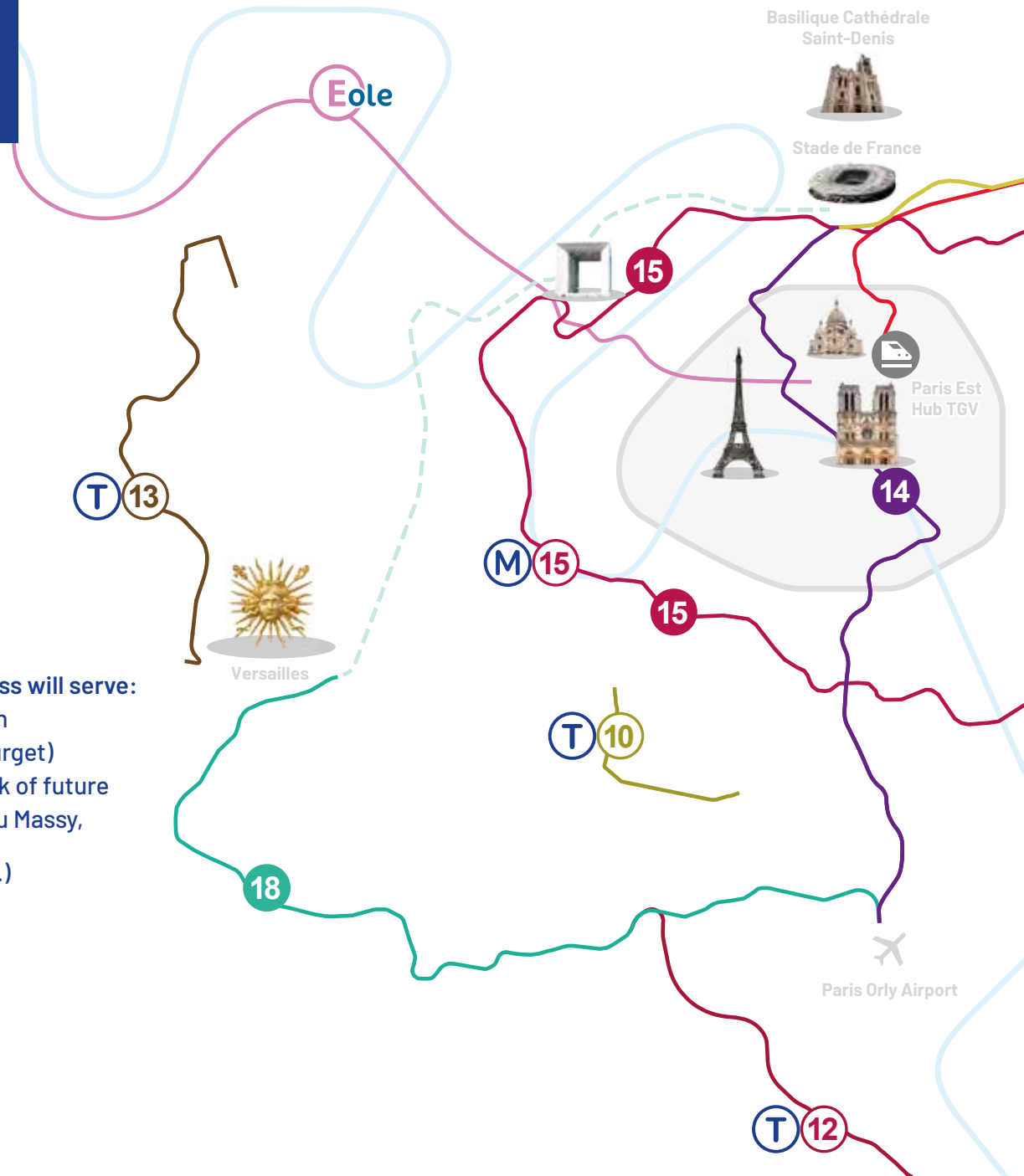

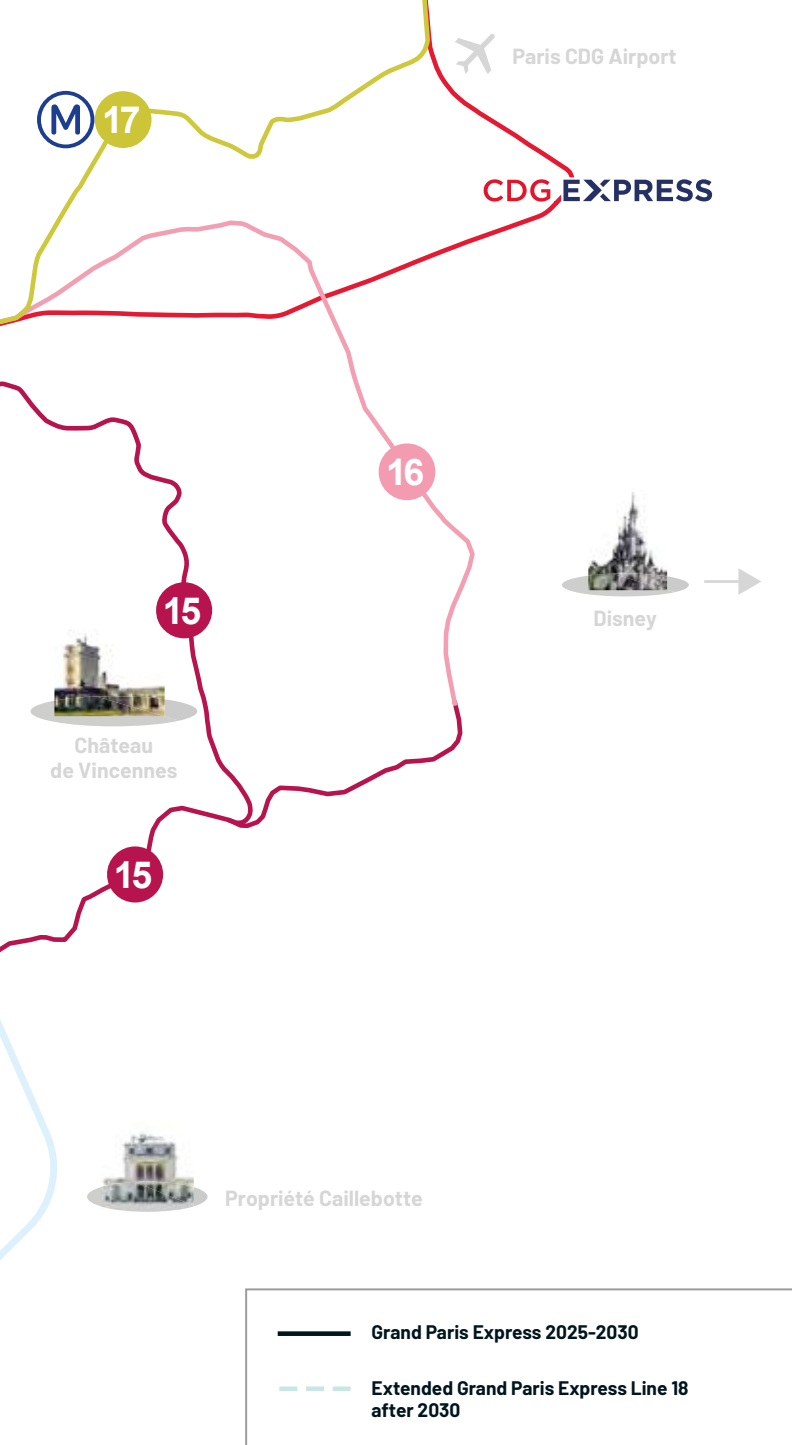
The Grand Paris Express:

- 200 km of new lines
- 68 stations, 80% of which are connected to the transport network
- 4 new lines: 15, 16, 17 and 18
- 2 extended lines: 11 and 14

With 200 km of lines, the Grand Paris Express will serve:

- the three major airports in the Paris Region (Paris-Charles de Gaulle, Paris-Orly, Le Bourget)
- 656 cultural venues within a 10-minute walk of future stations, including Versailles and Pompidou Massy, the main business districts (La Défense, La Plaine Saint-Denis, Val de Fontenay, etc.)
