

Paris Region, 1st world tourist destination, is the destination which possesses the largest number of golf in France with not less than 71 golf courses.

In France, the golf is one of the most popular individual sports with approximately 780 000 people (Source: study Sportlab) which possess graduate's card in 2017.

The golf knows a big development since his return about the Olympics of Rio in 2016 and especially since France was chosen to welcome in 2018 Ryder Cup and the Olympics in 2024. Certain courses in Paris Region were drawn with the cooperation of big architects of golf such Tom Simpson, Ronald Fream, Robbert Van Hagge, Hubert Chesneau, Jack Nicklaus... etc.

Through a selection of the most beautiful golf courses and of sports events, the Paris Region Tourist Board proposes to discover the best that Paris and the surrounding region have to offer. Do a 9 hole in the morning, visit two castles in the afternoon, take a Paris by Night cruise and round off the evening in a jazz club. Culture, history, exceptional shopping, the famous French lifestyle, party venues and more... everything is within reach.

Without forgetting a selection of the big sports and cultural meetings which leads the destination and which make its wealth and its fame ceaselessly renewed.

## NORTHERN PARIS : FROM AUVERS-SUR-OISE TO ENGHIEN-LES-BAINS

Auvers is seriously beautiful, in the heart of the most picturesque and typical countryside, according to Van Gogh. In less than 70 days, he produced more than 80 works of art here! From its world-renowned church – the painting of it can be seen in the Musée d'Orsay – to its castle, Auvers really is like an open – air museum.

#### GOLF HOTEL \*\*\* DE MONT GRIFFON

The estate of the Oise Pays de France regional nature park is home to the largest training centre in Europe, with internationally recognised putting greens, over 4 courses.

36 holes over 3 courses.

- Lacs: 18 holes, 5 897 m, 72 par. The jewel of this resort, this course is renowned for the quality of its putting greens and its splendid panorama.
  - Forêt: 9 holes, 2800 m 35 par. Technically challenging course with undulating landscape.
- Arbalétrier : 9 compact holes, 877 m, 27 par. Two courses in one, ideal for learning golf and for putting practice.

#### ISLE-ADAM GOLF COURSE

Designed by Ronald Fream, this is one of the most beautiful golf courses in the region, a 200 hectare, protected site with an undulating terrain, hundred-year-old trees and panoramic views. It also offers a high-quality training pitch.

18 holes over 1 course

- Isle-Adam: 18 holes, 6 188 m, 75 par. A course alternating between narrow holes, long holes and vast sloping greens.

#### LYS CHANTILLY GOLF COURSE

This 120-hectare estate has 3 golf courses, including one designed in 1929 by Tom Simpson, as well as tennis courts once frequented by Borotra, Brugnon, Cochet and Lacoste, and a swimming pool for a sophisticated rural rendezvous on the outskirts of Paris.

45 holes, 3 courses

- Chênes: 18 holes on the Tom Simpson course, 5,905 m, 70 par: wooded, deceptively sloping surfaces, bunkers with turf-covered mounds, perfectly landscaped fairways.
  - Bouleaux: 18 holes, 4,930 m, 68 par. Short and narrow course requiring skill and technique.
  - Jacky Fruchet: Pitch & Putt, 9 holes, 940 m, 27 par. Compact, accessible, suitable for all levels.

#### **ROYAL GREEN**

## Château de Chantilly

Since the 19th century, this château with its gardens designed by Le Nôtre has been home to a prestigious collection of classical French and Italian paintings, considered to be the second most important collection after the Louvre. The Great Stables, among the most beautiful in the world, offer demonstrations of dressage and other equestrian shows under a majestic dome. Twice a year, the chateau organizes the Journées des Plantes de Chantilly, a horticultural and botanical event that started in Courson and is internationally renowned. <a href="https://www.domainedechantilly.com">www.domainedechantilly.com</a>

#### Abbaye de Royaumont

This exceptional heritage site is also a venue for exhibitions, concerts, shows and contemporary audio-visual installations. As well as the vegetable plot, this Cistercian jewel contains two extraordinary gardens: one is the backdrop for a modern art installation and the other presents a collection of vegetables of medieval origins and was created in order to host exhibitions of plants. www.royaumont.com

## **MUST-SEE**

#### Auvers-sur-Oise

Conserved landscapes and historical sites - Daubigny's house and workshop, Doctor Gachet's house, the cemetery where Van Gogh lies - all transform Auvers into an open-air museum. #### Auberge Ravoux, the house of Van Gogh

## Spark Barrière Enghien-les-Bains

Just 14 km from Paris, harmony and serenity reign in the only thermal resort in the region. Around the lake, next to the casino, lies a  $3,500 \text{ m}^2$  well-being, sports and treatment centre, with private swimming pool, aquatic circuit, saunas, Turkish baths, massage and balneotherapy cabins and a  $250 \text{ m}^2$  fitness room.

#### Casino Barrière

The only casino in the region, located on the edge of the lake, it includes 500 of the latest slot machines with touch screens and Hollywood themed scenarios, along with around forty gaming tables in the spacious lounges.

Spread over an 86-hectare expanse, you find island greens, ponds and sand banks. The golf course can be adapted for all levels of play, with its 3 courses of 9 holes, designed by Ronald Fream, which can be combined in di\_erent ways to make three distinct 18-hole routes.

## **ROYAL GREEN**

#### Château de Champs-sur-Marne

This is one of the most well-furnished 18<sup>th</sup> century châteaux in the Paris region, with exceptional painted décor. With the Marquise de Pompadour among its most illustrious guests, it recently played host to Sofia Coppola for the filming of "Marie-Antoinette". ## **MUST-SEE**

#### Museum of the Great War, Pays de Meaux

Possessing a collection which is unique in Europe, the permanent exhibition at this museum o\_ers a new perspective on the first global conflict (1914-1918) with its innovative displays. Technological advances (artillery, camouflage, communications), the place and role of women, the daily lives of soldiers, tactics and strategy, the Allied intervention... thematic spaces address different aspects of the conflict, so that visitors can be truly immersed in history. www.museedelagrandeguerre.eu

#### **Provins**

With its tunnels, ramparts and 58 historic monuments, this medieval city, listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site, will take you back to the Middle Ages. ## The Eagles of the Ramparts

This equestrian falconry show is unique in Europe, where eagles, buzzards, falcons, vultures and owls move in harmony with horses, wolves and camels.

## The Age of the Ramparts

Demonstration of real, life-size, medieval war machines, built exactly according to the ancient designs.

## SOUTH-EASTERN PARIS: FONTAINEBLEAU

Fontainebleau may be most famous for the chateau's royal former residents, but the town and surrounding area are also worth a visit. The vast forest is suitable for a wide range of activities (cycling, horse-riding, rock climbing), and the surrounding villages and countryside were beloved by the Impressionists and their predecessors.

## EXCLUSIV GOLF CHÂTEAU DE CÉLY

Renovated and transformed over the course of the centuries, the estate now has exceptional grounds of 55 ha on the edge of the forest of Fontainebleau. Set around the 14th century château, the undulating, landscaped course where each hole has an interesting perspective and a different viewpoint, can be played in many ways, like in the best American golfing tradition.

18 holes, 5,874 m, 72 par. In the middle of an oak forest, this landscaped course is adorned with waterfalls and flowerbeds.

## **ROYAL GREEN**

#### Château de Fontainebleau

Surrounded by 130 hectares of park and gardens, and listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site, the château was host to royal residents for eight centuries. François I, Henri IV and Louis XVI all left an exceptional artistic legacy from their time. Napoléon I, describing it as "a true residence of Kings, their home over the centuries", renovated and refurnished it. www.musee-chateau-fontainebleau.fr

#### Château de Vaux-le-Vicomte

A masterpiece of classical art, where the arts, good taste and sophistication come together, this estate is the work of three geniuses: the architect Le Vau, the painter Le Brun and the gardener Le Nôtre. It inspired the building of the Château de Versailles. From May to October, the grounds are lit with 2,000 candles, fireworks and a champagne bar in the gardens, for unforgettable moments. www.vaux-le-vicomte.com

#### Château de Courances

Privately owned and still lived in, the château blooms in a haze of trees, valleys and light. The 75 hectare park, listed as a *Jardin Remarquable*, reflects several eras: classical park in the 17<sup>th</sup> century, French style in the 18th century, Japanese gardens and more. Gourmet dinners are held here, cooked with organic vegetables from the kitchen garden, and 3 exceptional cottages are available for hire so guests can enjoy a break.

## Moret-sur-Loing

The medieval doors, the church of Notre-Dame, the bridge and the banks of the River Loing... *Le Pont de Moret, The Church at Moret (Evening), The Loing's Canal...* Nothing has changed from Sisley's time to present day. The majestic sweep of the Château de Versailles gardens is highlighted by the spectacular Great Fountains show. #### **GOLF NATIONAL**

## **SOUTH-WESTERN PARIS: RAMBOUILLET**

Chateaux of all styles, charming villages, picturesque landscapes to wander and explore... the Haute Vallée de Chevreuse nature reserve is full of treasures for those who love nature, culture, and sports and leisure. From local heritage to grand historical buildings, journey to the heart of a region covered in forest.

## EXCLUSIV GOLF COURSON - STADE FRANÇAIS

Over 110 hectares, surrounded by forest, this course is typical of the architectural style of Robert Von Hagge, who designed the terrain so that each fairway is isolated from the others. Undulating landscape, with tall grasses, large expanses of rough and areas covered in broom - emulating the seaside - are the mark of this high-ranking golf course, among the best in Europe.

36 holes over 4 courses, 6 possible combinations

- Green: 9 holes, 3,415 m, 36 par, hazard of strong winds.
- Black: 9 holes, 3,142 m, 36 par. This course requires a good knowledge of the landscape and a specific strategy for the final holes, with their many water obstacles.
- Lilas: 9 holes, 3,115 m, 36 par. For fans of "target golf". Generous use of water and bunkers in this American-style golf course.
- Orange: 9 holes, 3,069 m, 36 par. Bar, restaurant, club house. Golf escape package with Lucien Barrière.

This golf course will surprise you with its stunning natural environment: its 2 courses have been sculpted out of a 90-hectare national park on the edge of Rambouillet forest.

- Tilleuls: 9 holes, 2,065 m, 31 par. Beginner and training course, surrounded by hundred-year-old linden trees
